

ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2019-20

DEVELOPMENTAL WORK

1. The R.K. Hall has been converted to class rooms to conduct +2 Commerce classes. So, there was a great demand for **multi activity hall** where a number of group activities can be conducted. The construction of an Activity Centre for the conduct of TT / Chess / Yoga classes is going on in full swing over the existing 2nd floor of the Main Block.
2. The School Management takes necessary steps to upgrade and implement new system to keep pace with fast changing world. So, the **RFID attendance and academic software** are inducted in association with CAASP (P) Ltd. to update the parents with daily attendance, curricular transaction and extracurricular activities. The system is quite useful for all the stakeholders.
3. The ordinary cement flooring of the corridors and the class rooms constructed long back, have been damaged and so need renovation. During the current session, to start with, we have taken such areas in the corridors and the class rooms on the ground floors by fixing Kota Stone around 6730 Sqft. Such renovation work shall be extended in phased manner to rest of the floors.
4. The floor in front of the Primary Block at Gate No.4 and connecting Visitors Waiting space, has been renovated with Kota Stone flooring.
5. The security system of the school has been changed on priority basis in compliance with CBSE and State Govt. guidelines. CCTV surveillance, alongwith tightening of security system will enable us to thwart any untoward incident.
6. Visitor's Room of Main Block and Primary Block are installed with LED TVs for display of round the year activities and achievements of the School.
7. For the fitness of the students, sports equipments are installed in the field.
8. Robotics Laboratory is set up for the students of Std-III and IV and gradually the same facility will be extended upto +2 students.
9. Mini Library has been set up in +2 Block Lower Ground, which is equipped with reference books / magazines / periodicals etc. for +2 students reference.
10. Construction of stair-case in the Assembly Ground of the Main Block has been made as per the fire safety norms for easy evacuation of students during any emergency.

RESULTS OF BOARD EXAMINATION – 2019

BJEM School has always been outstanding for its track records in results.

- The results of Class-X for the Session 2018-19 was 100%. 246 students appeared the Class-X Board Examination. Out of them, 92 students secured 90% and above marks which is the second highest in the State. The School Topper Tanistha Mangaraj secured 98.6% (493 / 500). 21 students secured 100 in Social Science, 7 in Mathematics, 5 in Sanskrit and 1 in Science.
- In Class-XII, 188 students appeared the Board Examination in Science Stream and 69 students in Commerce Stream. 47 students secured 90% and above marks in Science. The School Topper in Science Sattwik Mishra secured 97.2 % (486 / 500). Four students have secured 90% and above marks in Commerce. The school topper in Commerce Jayabrat Dash secured 95.8% (479 / 500).
